



## Living in the wood pile

Panter Hudspith Architects has been awarded planning permission by Southwark Council for its Mulberry Park mixed-use scheme at Canada Water.

Situated on the site of a former timber yard, the development references timber stacks in its design and comprises 256 residential units, and light industrial, retail and leisure space now occupied by warehouses and offices. Residential units are separated from each other with recessed balconies and facade elements.

In the 19th century, the site housed docks that stored imported timber.
